

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS 3 WEEK MINUTES

- **Motion: To approve the meeting minutes from the last three weeks.**
- Moved by: Phil

- Vote: Passed unanimously with the abstention of Will.

GUELPH ENGINEERING COMPETITION (GEC) AND ONTARIO ENGINEERING COMPETITION (OEC)

Presented by: Sabine

- Concerns raised regarding GEC planning and its relationship to OEC.
- Noted that CoCreCo typically runs GEC; however, there is minimal overlap.
- Sabine and Abby will co-chair GEC. Dates and timelines have already been determined by them.
- Discussion on whether CoCreCo was informed of this transition — Abby noted CoCreCo had not responded to outreach and did not attend the last meeting.
- Priority emphasized on ensuring the event runs smoothly as it reflects on EngSoc.
- Sabine plans to present a motion at SAGM for having two co-chairs for GEC under External Affairs.
- Phil recommended proceeding with planning while still attempting contact with CoCreCo or their faculty advisor.
- Jo suggested voting to formally give Abby and Sabine jurisdiction to proceed.
- **Motion:** That Guelph Engineering Society take over planning for GEC due to CoCreCo's lack of activity, pending further developments (e.g., faculty advisor response).

WELLNESS ROOM CONCERNS

Presented by: Phil

- Reports of disruptive, loud behavior and inappropriate discussions, including hate speech and catcalling.
- Discussion on potential responses:
 - **Charles:** Suggested the ability to permanently ban offenders.
 - **Elaine:** Suggested signage indicating it is an EngSoc space and raised privacy concerns about cameras.
 - **Emma:** Proposed closing the room by 5 PM and contacting campus or Guelph Police if hate speech continues.
 - **Sydney:** Recommended temporarily closing the space as it's causing more harm than good.
 - **Elaine:** Suggested combining closure with wellness lounge renovations.
 - **Roni:** Advised against surveillance; proposed signage explaining the closure and consequences for hate speech.

Motion: To close the wellness lounge immediately (with 1-day notice for belongings), install signage explaining the reason for closure, and note that hate speech elsewhere in the building will result in campus police involvement.
